The mission of the Office of the City Auditor is to improve the performance and accountability of the City of Portland government. To address this mission, we need objective information on how well City services are provided. The attached survey is intended to provide some of this information from the point of view of <u>businesses</u>.

My office has published an independent report on the performance of major City services for the past 15 years that includes the results of a *citizen* satisfaction survey*. However, **little citywide** verifiable information on how *businesses* rate services has been collected.

This year we are conducting our fourth **business survey** to gather satisfaction ratings specifically from the <u>business point of view</u>. The business at this location has been randomly chosen to be in this confidential, citywide survey.
